WHAT MEAT(S) WILL YOU BE COOKING?

THERE IS NO ENTRY FEE. THE PURPOSE OF THIS COMPETITION IS TO RAISE MONEY FOR CHARITABLE AND NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS. OF COURSE, WE ALSO WANT TO AWARD ***BRAGGING RIGHTS*** TO THE BEST BARBEQUE IN LOUISVILLE!

THERE ARE THREE DIVISIONS:

AMATEUR BACKYARD SMOKERS: Individuals in this division are limited to the use of grills, smokers, etc., including Big Green Egg and similar cookers or smokers that they use in their backyard and not for the typical team competition.

TEAMS: Barbeque teams are not limited in the type of equipment used to prepare their entries

COMMERCIAL: Barbeque teams are not limited in the type of equipment used to prepare their entries

FOUR TROPHIES WILL BE AWARDED:

FAB FEAST TROPHY: Awarded to the besting tasting barbeque in the Commercial division

TOP HOG TROPHY: Awarded to the besting tasting barbeque in the Team division

BIG PIG TROPHY: Awarded to the best tasting in the Amateur Backyard Smoker Division

PEOPLE'S CHOICE TROPHY: Awarded to the Team, Amateur Backyard Smoker, or Commercial that raises the most money for their designated nonprofit or charity.

BARBEQUE CONTEST RULES

1. MEAT FOR THE CONTEST MAY BE FRESH OR FROZEN. MEAT MAY NOT BE PRE-COOKED, SAUCED, SPICED, INJECTED, MARINATED, CURED IN ANY WAY, OR OTHERWISE PRE-TREATED PRIOR TO THE START OF COMPETITION ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2017.
2. **YOU MAY ENTER MORE THAN ONE TYPE OF MEAT.**
3. COMPETITORS MAY COOK WITH ANY TYPE OF WOOD AND/OR CHARCOAL. OTHER TYPES OF FLAMMABLES, SUCH AS PROPANE, MAY BE USED WITHIN THE COOKER ONCE THE MEAT HAS BEEN PLACED THERE.
4. CHECK-IN WILL BEGIN AT 9:00 AM ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 19th AT LOUISVILLE TOWN HALL. YOU WILL BE GIVEN YOUR ASSIGNED SPACE AT CHECK-IN.
5. YOU MUST HAVE A FIRE EXTINGUISHER AT YOUR SITE.
6. ELECTRICITY WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE. THE USE OF GENERATORS IS ALLOWED.
6. PLEASE DISPOSE OF TRASH AND GREASE IN APPROPRIATE CONTAINERS.
8. SEPARATE BARBEQUE TURN-IN TIMES WILL BE ASSIGNED FOR EACH MEAT ENTERED IN THE COMPETITION.
9. TEAMS ARE ENCOURAGED TO SELL BARBEQUE AND OTHER FOOD ITEMS. ALL PROFITS FROM THE SALE OF BARBEQUE AND DRINKS MUST GO TO THE DESIGNATED CHARITY OR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION. ALL DRINKS SELL FOR \$1.
10. JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT 1:00 PM ON SATURDAY. TURN-IN TIMES WILL BE ASSIGNED ON SATURDAY MORNING.
